

Choosing Non-Citizens Over Georgia Children

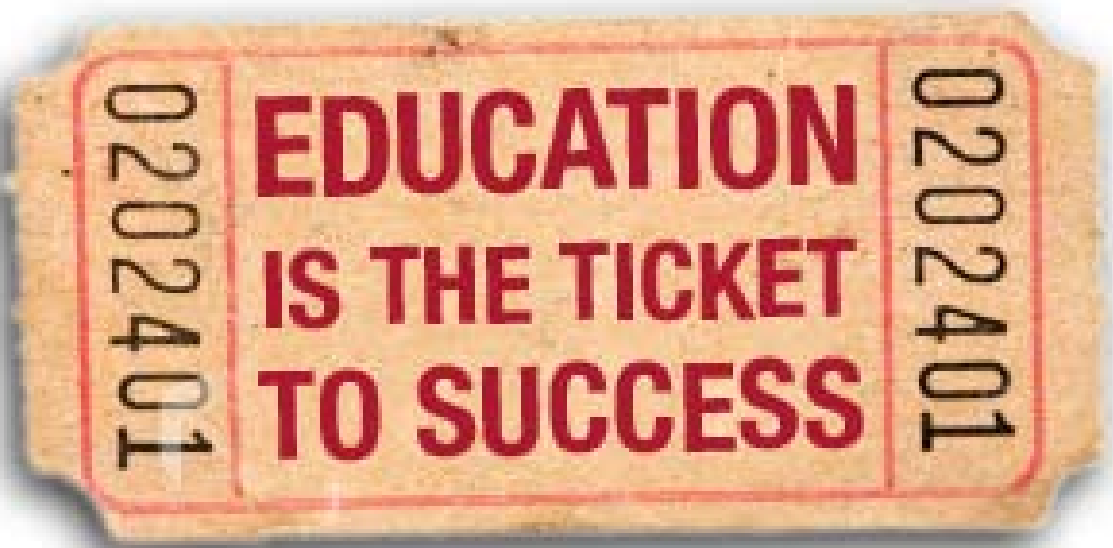
John Barrow made the wrong choice.
